This document allows you to authorize your instructor _____ (Faculty Name) and/or institution _____ (School Name) to disclose specific information (your name and the course you took) with the Faculty Submitted Student Work (FSSW) Exhibition sponsored by the ACM SIGGRAPH Educator's Committee. This information would then be available at the annual SIGGRAPH conference and on the Education Committee website archives.

The inclusion of your work is an honor, but in order for your name to be included in the exhibit alongside your work you must give written authorization for your faculty/institution to release your name in association with the courses in which that work was created.
